

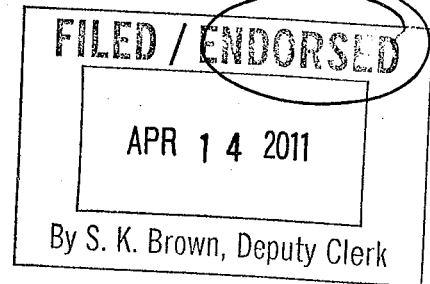

24 On March 25, 2011 the Court granted the Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings  
25 on the First Cause of Action for Declaratory Relief contained in the First Amended  
26 Complaint filed by the Plaintiff counties. The Court found that Plaintiffs were entitled to  
27 a judgment as a matter of law.

28 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:**

The mandate placed upon the counties known as AB 3632 is suspended for fiscal  
year 2010-2011. Plaintiffs are entitled to the judgment on their complaint as a matter of  
law. Plaintiff counties need not provide any services which fall under the provisions or  
requirements of AB 3632 mandate, codified in Chapter 26.5 of the Government Code, for




