BACKGROUND:

The Accredited Standards Committee X12 (ASC X12) publishes Type 3 Technical Reports, commonly known as Implementation Guides (IG), which define the data to be included in ASC X12 transaction sets for specific business purposes. HIPAA requires covered entities to utilize the 5010 versions of the IG as of 1/1/2012. These guides are copyrighted documents and must be purchased from Washington Publishing on behalf of ASC X12.

Companion Guides contain information for creating transactions for a specific trading partner based on an associated ASC X12 IG. ASC X12 and industry representatives developed the Transaction Information (TI) template that must be used for Companion Guides. The TI template contains requirements and restrictions that constrain the content of Companion Guides.

ADP, DHCS and DMH are planning to provide a Short-Doyle Medi-Cal 5010 Trading Partner Companion Guide Walk Through. This document will help you prepare for the meeting and determine what staff may be most appropriate in attending the Short-Doyle Medi-Cal 5010 Trading Partner Companion Guide Walk Through.
