The EO works with a 40-member body appointed by the Director of the State Department of Mental Health to:

- advise the Legislature and the State Department of Mental Health on mental health policies and priorities

Additionally, the EO collaborates with mental health constituency groups throughout the state on the development of mental health policy and system change.

This position is responsible for supervising 8 staff.
