I just heard a couple of stories from our Forensic Supervisor yesterday and thought I would share them with you. Recently there was a 109 released from prison and told to report to our county. Instead, he went to his mother's house in Chico and beat her to death.

The culture in our county jail has dramatically changed to be more of a prison culture. In the past the "rule" in the county jail was that if you had a grudge with someone from a prison, you would deal with it at the prison and not at the county jail. That has now changed and there are more fights breaking out at the county jail.
