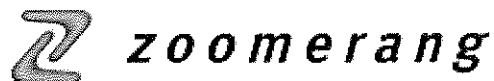
- 1 Our clinical unit is too small for a service dedicated to any one system of care.
- 2 We are in the process of developing an older adult system of care using MHSA dollars to supplement gaps in the continuum.
- 3 Small county program for adults 60+ funded by MHSA/CSS
- 4 Provide targeted services and EBP for older adults with SMI
- 5 It is a small SOC consisting of older adult FSP, APS, Senior Peer Counseling
- 6 We have behavioral health system of care between the different programs (Recovery, PACT and OASIS). We have the southern region and statewide OASOC. We also have the OA Committee that has system partners (non behavioral health) attending. What we don't have is a hands on working partnership or a system of care, say for e.g. with PCPs. Alzheimer's association care giver groups...
- 7 OASOC of L.A. Region comprises mental health providers, consumers, client coalitions, families, allied / partner agencies, mental health commissioners. Committee has average membership attendance of 45, and meets monthly.
- 8 We provide outpatient mental health services to Older Adults. We are one of the few agencies that have a specialized Older Adult team. We work within the framework of the Santa Clara County mental health department Adult System.

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3. How do you currently measure recovery of your older adult clients?

**# Response**

- 1 THE SYSTEM IS FAIRLY NEW AND I DO NOT KNOW THE PARTICULARS.
- 2 We have no formal measuring tool. Mostly it is anecdotal information.
- 3 yes  
the PAF (Partnership Assessment Form)--done at opening of client in any of the FSP programs, or if not open to any FSP program for 12 months or longer, this is a 8 page form that looks at residence, financial information, employment information, hospitalization and residence changes, etc --the KET (Key Event Tracking), done at every change, residence, hospitalization, emergency room visits, hospitalization (even an ER visit), all residential changes tht include 1 night in a setting and --the 3M (3 Months) form. done every three months as long as a client is in service.
- 4  
For the few OA FSP, we use KET and 6MO forms. Also, our EHR system (Avatar) can be used to check for frequency of contact. Most often, however, progress is noted by observation of OA Clinical Supervisor, who monitors clients' situations until they are stable, when they may be referred to other appropriate agencies.
- 5 Use adult MORS, IMR, RMQ and SATS-R ( if applicable) also measure and track employment, education and residential goals
- 6 Reduced symptoms, increased or maintenance of functioning, avoidance of acute care, sense of hope.
- 7 On an individual basis.
- 8 Largely utilize the MHSA performance Outcome information. Beyond that we focus consumer wishes; supports to stay as independent as possible, housing, health and mental health improvement.
