Program Philosophy

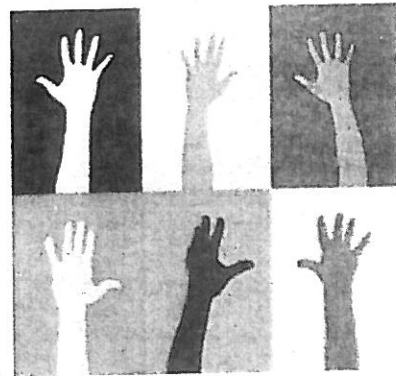
