Sonoma County has a TAY FSP that serves 40 young adults ages 18 – 25. We provide intensive services including case management, medication support services, assistance with housing, education, employment, benefits procurement, and socialization. The program is run by Sonoma County Mental Health, and contract with Buckelew Programs and Social Advocates for Youth to provide housing services. We also work closely with the consumer-run Wellness and Advocacy Center, which runs a TAY group, and with VOICES, and drop-in support and resource center for youth, focusing on former foster and homeless youth.
