While in our program we ask that you:

- ✓ Obtain/maintain a full-time job (40 hours)-OR- attend school full time while working a minimum of 15 hours per week
- ✓ Obtain a high school diploma or GED while enrolled (if not already received)
- ✓ Participate fully in the graduated rent payment system, (maximum graduated payment not to exceed 30% of income)
- ✓ Open a savings account within 90 days
- ✓ Attend mandatory group meetings and host support group meetings on a rotating schedule.
- ✓ Agree to consider mental and physical health recommendations from health professionals
- ✓ Agree to follow all *New Directions* program and apartment complex rules.
- ✓ Attend mandatory weekly case management meetings with your Advocate/Educator.

Current benefits of our program:

- **Monthly food stipend:** Each participant will receive a gift card to a local grocery store each month.
- **Emancipation fund:** Every month that you are in the program we will put 50\$ into an account. No one can touch this account until you leave. This means if you stay in the full two years you will have accrued 1200\$.
- **Matched Savings Account:** We will match up to 25\$ a month that you save. This comes out to 300\$/year. (If you save 300\$, we match it with 300\$).
- **Transportation:** Currently each participant will receive a monthly bus pass or a gift card for gas if they own a vehicle (must have valid license, insurance and registration).
- **Furnishings:** All apartments are fully furnished. Participants that leave on good terms after 9 months in the program will be able to take all furnishings with them.
