Topics of General Discussion:

- Announcements
 - It was noted that we missed the submission deadline for the CMHACY conference for this year, but we can try again next year.

- Discuss Possible Topics for Presentation at a Future All Director's Meeting
 - Some possible topics for a presentation at the June All Directors Meeting could be:
 - Housing strategies
 - Vocational information
 - Educational information
 - Could move into more of a practice topic or could discuss co-occurring disorders.

- County and Agency Reports
 - Los Angeles
 - Terri Boykins reported that they have resolved the AB 3632 problem through June 30th.
 - For their PEI programs they have put out over 20 Evidence-Based Practices.
 - They have a number of direct operated programs.
 - Sacramento
 - Last year they talked about CSS money being used for a juvenile justice diversion treatment program.
 - They have just completed an RFA for a program focused on the onset of early psychosis.
 - Contra Costa
 - It was noted that they are currently discussing setting up their own juvenile justice program in the county.
 - Monterey
 - They are starting construction on a house for TAY, and each TAY will get his or her own room.
 - They have talked with the community about this new house.
 - Humboldt
 - It was reported that they are looking at models like TIP.
 - Fred Finch
 - Susanna Marshland reported that they will help fund a new building that has five MHSA units. The building will be for permanent supportive housing for TAY who are homeless and have a mental illness. The building will be located in Berkeley.
